# **GPA Requirements**

Students must maintain an overall 2.0 GPA and a 2.0 in-major GPA. In-major GPA is calculated on all ART courses.

## Satisfactory Progress Toward Degree

Students must successfully pass portfolio review in Visual Communication Design to take any courses higher than 2XXX. In addition to the university requirement for satisfactory progress (see Satisfactory Progress in Undergraduate catalog) upon completion of 72 semester credits, students must have completed all second year in-major courses with a C- or higher.

## Prerequisites

## Foreign Language Requirement

Students who do not successfully complete at least two units of a single foreign language, classical language or American Sign Language during high school must successfully complete six semester hours of a single college level foreign language or classical language at the college level.
