#### Overall GPA

Students majoring in Art History must maintain a 2.0 in-major and overall GPA.

#### Progress towards Degree:

The University requires every department to establish benchmarks by which their majors can demonstrate that they are making satisfactory progress toward a degree. In the case of the Art History major these benchmarks are:

- 1) Students must maintain an overall GPA of 2.0 and an in-major GPA of 2.0.
- 2) Upon having attempted 72 semester hours (including transfer, AP, advanced standing and credit by exam) an Art History student must have completed at least 6 credits towards this major with a 2.0 overall GPA and have a minimum of a 2.0 in-major GPA.
