Overall GPA

Students majoring in Art History must maintain a 2.0 in-major and overall GPA.

In-Major GPA

A grade of C- or better is required to successfully complete an Art History Course (2385, 2386, 3084, 3074, 3174, 3184, 3284, 3384, 3384, 3484, 3584, 3684, 3884, 3784, 3774, 3054, 3064, 4484, 4384, ARCH 4284). All Art History courses must be successfully completed in order to meet course prerequisites of successive classes.

Progress towards Degree:

The University requires every department to establish benchmarks by which their majors can demonstrate that they are making satisfactory progress toward a degree. In the case of the Art History major these benchmarks are:

- 1) Students must maintain an overall GPA of 2.0 and an in-major GPA of 2.0.
- 2) Upon having attempted 72 semester hours (including transfer, AP, advanced standing and credit by exam) an Art History student must have completed at least 6 credits towards this major with a 2.0 overall GPA and have a minimum of a 2.0 in-major GPA.
