(22 hours)**

Requirements for Minor

1. Satisfactory completion of The Leadership Progression within the Virginia Tech Corps of Cadets. (The Leadership Progression is defined below)
2. A minimum of 22 credit hours consisting of:
 - A minimum of 7 credit hours of the following courses:
 - A. MGT 3304: Mgt. Th. & Lead. Pract. (3 hrs)
 - B. A minimum of 4 credit hours in Corps Lab
(Corps Lab hours can be any combination of MGT 2944 Military Leadership Practicum, taken Pass/Fail only and MGT 4944 Leading in Your Profession, which can be taken up to two times as A-F only. MGT 4944 requires senior standing in the Corps.)
 - A minimum of 3 credit hours of coursework from Group I
 - A minimum of 12 credit hours of coursework from Group II
3. A minimum minor grade point average of 2.0 in all courses taken to fulfill the minor is required.
4. A minimum of six hours of coursework at the 3000-level or above must be taken to fulfill the minor requirements.

The Leadership Progression

The Leadership Progression is defined as a minimum of four semesters' participation in the Virginia Tech Corps of Cadets, including participation in the New Cadet System; satisfactory completion of at least two Corps leadership positions, and having passed at least once during a cadet career, an ROTC or Corps Physical Fitness test (or alternate test in case of physical disability). Corps leadership positions which satisfy this requirement are those which have direct supervisory responsibility over other cadets and include: Team Leader, Cadre Corporal/Sergeant, Squad Leader, Platoon Sergeant, First Sergeant, Battalion and Regimental Sergeants Major, Platoon Leader, Company, Battalion and Regimental Executive Officer, any command position, and selected Battalion and Regimental Staff positions which have supervisory responsibility over other cadets.

Note: University policy limits the number of Pass/Fail credits a student may take to 10% of total number of credits needed to graduate. For example, a transfer student who needs only 80 credits to graduate is limited to 8 Pass/Fail credits. Students who are affected by this limitation should discuss it with their advisors.
