- Support student-athletes in balancing their academic and athletic demands.
- Tutoring (Will Hozey)
 - Recruit, educate, and evaluate tutors
 - Grades First system for tutor requests
 - New Reading Day Initiative (walk in tutor opportunities)
- Learning Assistant Program (Mary Anne Steinberg)
 - New students are evaluated to see if they need additional services or support
 - Programming available on Canvas

- Summer Academy

- All tutors are paid. We like to be able to offer employment for students as well.
- Numbers look great, but what are we in danger of?
 - We have improved as an academic support staff
 - Continue to develop student-athlete accountability
 - Small percentage of athletes in “at-risk” group, SAASS provides additional resources for this group to ensure future success
- We bring in higher percentage of diversity than on campus and first-generation college attendees
- Do we have a summary of the service contributions of student-athletes?
 - Reyna Gilbert-Lowry runs office of Student-Development which oversees community outreach
 - Can provide more data
- Students should also have strong relationships with their academic advisor on campus
