6. Pathways Annual Grants Update (Stephen Biscotte)

The deadline for the Pathways 2020 Grant cycle just closed on March 1.

- 28 grant proposals were received from a total of five colleges (CLAHS, COS, CALS, CNRE, PCOB).
- 19 proposals were for courses (either new or revised), 2 were to create new minors and courses, and 7 were to revise existing minors
- Announcements of awards will be made within the next few weeks
