#### 2. Chair and Vice Chair Nominations and Vote

Hannah Shinault was unanimously elected as chair, and Aaron Ansell was unanimously elected as vice chair.

#### 3. Pathways Updates

- During AY 2021-21, 62 Pathways courses and 9 Pathways minors were approved, and the Office of Gen Ed conducted 186 transfer credit reviews.
- As of Sep. 1, 2021, 825 students are enrolled in Pathways minors. This is down slightly from 916 in the spring due to students graduating. Enrollment and completion data for Pathways minors can be accessed <a href="here">here</a>.
- Today (Sep. 1) is the final day to sign up for the assessment grants (Parts I and II). Part III will be available in the spring.
- During Inclusive VT Week (Sep. 6-10), several speakers will present on aspects of student belonging. Details are linked in the <u>Canvas folder</u> for the 9/1 meeting materials.
- The Office of Gen Ed has created just under 100 major-specific flyers that highlight how Pathways minors can help students meet their general education requirements. The college-approved flyers can be viewed <a href="here">here</a>, and more will continue to be added as they are approved.
  - Suggestion made for the advising subcommittee to point to some double majors that could be mapped against Pathways minors.
