**WHEREAS**, students who complete Associate's degrees from Virginia Community Colleges get their Pathways General Education requirements at Virginia Tech waived; and

**WHEREAS**, the university is expecting to increase transfer enrollment in the next four years, and this modification would create increased flexibility for transfer students and students entering Virginia Tech with a completed bachelor's degree; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed modification would increase opportunities for flexibility within degree programs;

**THEREFORE**, let it be resolved that for students enrolling at Virginia Tech seeking a second or additional bachelor's degree, a bachelor's degree at another 4-year institution is equivalent to completing Pathways general education requirements at Virginia Tech.
