To earn a minor in **War and Society**, a student must satisfactorily complete a minimum of 18 semester hours from the approved list of required courses and electives and achieve a minimum 2.0 GPA in all courses taken to satisfy the minor. No more than 6 hours of 1xxx courses may count towards the minor. No more than 50% of the graded course credit required for the War and Society may double-count by a student also enrolled in a History Major or Minor. Substitutions are allowed for independent studies, special studies courses and undergraduate research, if the topic is appropriate and if the advisor has granted permission.
