Normally only one Independent Study (AINS 2974 or 4974, or another departmental Independent Study course approved by the American Indian Studies director) will be accepted for credit. The Special Study courses (AINS 2984 or 4984, or another department equivalent approved by the American Indian Studies director) may be taken more than once if the topic of each course is different. A minimum GPA of 2.0 in all courses taken to fulfill the minor is required.
