A student must complete all courses with at least a minimum 2.0 Minor GPA for all hours attempted. In addition, as of fall 1989, a minimum grade of C (2.0) is required of Foreign Language majors and minors in all required courses for the major or minor. No more than 18 of the last 45 hours may be taken elsewhere, and those 18 hours must be approved courses. Required courses may be transferred only with approval of the Chair of the Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures. A form for authorization to transfer coursework done elsewhere should be obtained from the Dean's Office, filled out, and approved by the Chair of the Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures before the courses to be transferred have been taken.
